**Order Addressing
Respondents' Query**

Respondent Marian P. Young emailed my office requesting that Respondents be allowed to include additional evidence with their brief due on May 7, 2019. It is my understanding that the Division of Enforcement objects to the request. The email chain has been made part of the record of this proceeding maintained by the Office of the Secretary.

Respondents previously agreed to rely on the prior record and did not indicate that they would offer additional evidence. The email indicates a change of position. I will not preemptively deny them the opportunity to offer additional evidence given that they are pro se. If Respondents include new evidence with their brief, I will apply the rules concerning the admissibility of evidence and consider any objections by the Division. *See, e.g.*, 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.320, .321. I defer ruling on Respondents' request until, and if, it is necessary to do so.
