Order Addressing
Joint Stipulation
on Constitutional Defenses

On August 27, 2019, the parties submitted a joint stipulation agreeing that nine affirmative defenses raised by Respondent Christopher M. Gibson alleging constitutional infirmities in this proceeding are preserved for review by the Securities and Exchange Commission without my needing to address them in the initial decision.

I accept the stipulation; the defenses are preserved for Commission review and the parties need not discuss them in their post-hearing briefs. However, should Gibson continue to raise a due process violation because of alleged misrepresentations by the Division of Enforcement to witnesses during the investigation, I will be required to rule on it.¹
