Yesterday, I held a prehearing conference attended by counsel for the Division of Enforcement and Respondent Can-Cal Resources Ltd.

We discussed whether Can-Cal wished to waive its right to a hearing where witnesses would be called and cross-examined and instead resolve the case on the written record. The parties were directed to file a letter by November 25, 2019, apprising me of Can-Cal's decision. If Can-Cal waives its right to a hearing, the letter shall suggest a schedule for the submission of further briefing and evidence. If Can-Cal does not waive its right to a hearing, the letter should include a proposed procedural schedule for the submission of witness and exhibit lists and for holding a hearing to commence sometime in January 2020 at a location agreed to by the parties.
