Order Extending Briefing Schedule

Sears. The report states that the Division has produced part of the file and plans to produce the remainder by June 15, 2020.

Because the opposition to the Division's motion is currently due on June 12, 2020, I find good cause to EXTEND the briefing schedule as follows.¹

July 17, 2020: File opposition to motion for summary disposition.

July 27, 2020: File reply, if any.

If there are additional delays in the production of the investigative file or any other delays beyond Sears's control, he may request additional time in which to complete and file his opposition.
