**Order Granting Motion to
Postpone Hearing**

On January 4, 2022, the parties filed a joint motion to postpone the hearing and associated deadlines for 90 days. The parties believe that this extension may allow them to resolve by negotiation the only remaining issue in the proceeding. After considering the factors in 17 C.F.R. § 201.161(b), I find good cause to grant the parties' motion. In light of the timing requirements in 17 C.F.R. § 201.360(a)(2)(ii), no further extensions will be granted on this basis.

I ORDER the following revised schedule:

April 11, 2022: Exchange and file witness and exhibit lists.

May 2, 2022: File prehearing briefs.

File motions in limine, including any objections to
witness and exhibit lists.

File stipulations, admissions of fact, and requests for
official notice.

Deadline for requests under Rule 232 for subpoenas
requiring the attendance and testimony of a witness
at the hearing.

May 9, 2022: Final telephonic prehearing conference.

May 16, 2022: Hearing begins, either virtually or in person at a location to be determined in Texas.
