The Securities and Exchange Commission instituted this proceeding against Respondent Jason Jianxun Tang, CPA, with an Order Instituting Proceedings (OIP), pursuant to Sections 4C and 21C of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 102(e) of the Commission's Rules of Practice (ROP), 17 C.F.R. § 201.102(e), on November 17, 2022. Pursuant to Respondent's Offer of Settlement, the OIP made various findings of fact and conclusions of law, imposed remedial sanctions and a cease and desist order, and ordered a hearing before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge to determine what, if any civil penalties are appropriate under Section 21C of the Exchange Act.

It will be helpful to hold a telephonic prehearing conference in the near future to discuss various details of the way forward, such as a proposed procedural schedule, including filing dates for a dispositive motion pursuant to Rule 250 of the ROP, the estimated length of the hearing, arrangements for video conferencing the hearing, any need for in-person hearing sessions, and the presently estimated number and availability of witnesses. The parties should propose, by November 30, 2022, dates and times during December 2022 when they will be available for the prehearing conference.

The parties are reminded that service of all orders and rulings on parties is made by the Commission's Office of the Secretary, or other duly authorized Commission officer, in accordance with Rule 141 of the ROP. Instructions for parties and all notices, orders, and decisions issued by an administrative law judge are posted on the Commission's website at <http://www.sec.gov/alj>.
