THE REGISTRATION STATEMENT OF : ORDER AMERICAN CRYPTOFED DAO LLC :

The Securities and Exchange Commission instituted this proceeding with an Order Instituting Proceedings (OIP) on November 18, 2022. The proceeding is a stop order proceeding, authorized pursuant to Section 8(d) of the Securities Act of 1933. As the Commission ordered, the hearing before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge in this proceeding commenced at 10:00 a.m. EST on December 1, 2022. Hearing sessions were held on December 1, 2, and 6, 2022. The Division of Enforcement (Division) concluded its presentation of its direct case on December 2. Tr. 396. Thereafter, following the undersigned's explanation of procedure and applicable law on December 2 and 6, Respondent continued with the presentation of its direct case on December 6.² Tr. 459. Hearing sessions are set to resume on January 18, 2023, at 10:00 a.m. EST (7:00 a.m. PST). Tr. 604.

Respondent proposed several Division attorneys as witnesses. Tr. 12.³ This request was denied. Tr. 451, 605. Respondent was ordered to submit, by December 20, 2022: a list of topics on which it would examine such a witness if it wished to renew its request; and a list of exhibits from the Division's "Rule 230" production that it proposed to offer for admission. Tr. 436, 454, 605.
