The Securities and Exchange Commission instituted these proceedings on November 8, 2024: pursuant to Section 203(c)(2)(B) of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940, as to Epic Capital Wealth Advisors, LLC. On January 23, 2025, the Commission issued its Order Setting Proceeding for Expedited Hearing. Hearing sessions were held on June 2, 3, 4, and 10, 2025; and a number of exhibits were admitted into evidence. The hearing was closed on June 10. This Order addresses the Division of Enforcement's June 17, 2025, filing of a joint admitted exhibit list and the Division's admitted exhibits.

While helpful, the filing does not fully comply with the instructions of the undersigned and the requirements of Rule 351 of the Commission's Rules of Practice – it omits reference to any offered but excluded exhibit[s]. Accordingly, the filing of an amended joint exhibit list that includes both admitted exhibits *and* offered but excluded exhibit[s] will be due on June 25, 2025.
