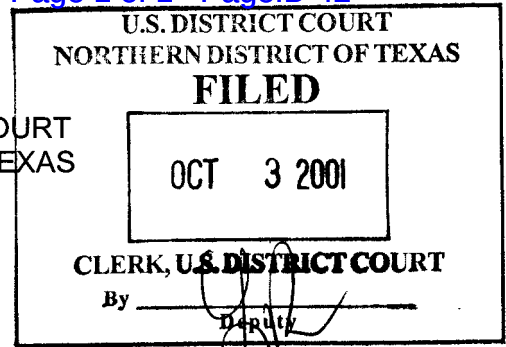

ORDER SETTING CIVIL PENALTY

BEFORE THE COURT for consideration is Plaintiff Securities and Exchange Commission's Application To Set Civil Penalty in the above numbered cause. After considering the Commission's application and the reasons and facts set forth therein, the court hereby grants the application.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Defendant Larry W. Ellis shall, within 120 days of the entry of this Order, pay the full amount of civil penalty, totaling \$110,000, to the United States Treasury. Such payment shall be: (a) made by United States postal money order, certified check, bank cashier's check or bank money order; (b) made payable to the Securities and Exchange Commission; (c) hand-delivered or mailed to the Comptroller, Securities and Exchange Commission, Operations Center, 6432 General Green Way, Stop 0-3, Alexandria, VA 22312; and (d) submitted under cover letter that identifies Defendant Lewis as a defendant in this civil action, and the docket number hereof, a copy of which cover letter and money order or check shall be sent to Harold F. Degenhardt, District Administrator, Securities and Exchange Commission, Fort Worth District Office, 801 Cherry Street, Unit 18, Ft. Worth, Texas 76102.
