SECOND ORDER TO DISBURSE FUNDS FOR DISTRIBUTION**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that, upon the accompanying Motion, Memorandum, Declaration, and Proposed Order, and all other related papers and proceedings, Plaintiff, the Securities and Exchange Commission (the "SEC") will move this Court, at a date and time to be determined by the Court, for an Order to Disburse Funds for Distribution so that the Court-appointed Distribution Agent can distribute the AR Capital Fair Fund to investors eligible for a second distribution under the Court-approved Distribution Plan. MOTION

In accordance with the Distribution Plan approved by this Court on May 18, 2021, the SEC respectfully submits this Motion for an Order: (1) authorizing the SEC staff to transfer \$91,714.02 to the escrow account established by the Distribution Agent at The Huntington

National Bank, N.A.; and (2) authorizing the Distribution Agent to distribute \$2,331,786.67 to Eligible Claimants in accordance with the Distribution Plan.
