CCUS is an indirect, wholly-owned subsidiary of Cboe Global Markets, Inc. ("CGM"). An organizational chart for CGM, including CCUS, is attached as Exhibit C-1. As the chart indicates, CGM, a public company owned by public shareholders and listed for trading on the Cboe BZX Exchange, currently has a number of direct wholly-owned subsidiaries as well as a variety of indirect subsidiaries, including CCUS. CCUS is a CFTC-registered derivatives clearing organization.

A chart depicting the internal organizational structure of CCUS with regard to its clearing agency activities is attached as Exhibit C-2. In addition to their reporting relationships within CCUS's organizational structure, the officers of CCUS depicted in the chart, as well as any other employees of CGM businesses assigned to work on CCUS's clearing agency activities, may have reporting relationships to other CGM businesses. Those reporting relationships will correspond to the departments with which the officers' or employees' duties are associated.
