Crypto Task Force

Designation

On January 21, 2025, I announced that I had launched a crypto task force dedicated to developing a comprehensive and clear regulatory framework for crypto assets. In this work, this task force will collaborate with Commission staff and the public. The task force will help the Commission draw clear regulatory lines, provide realistic paths to registration, craft sensible disclosure frameworks, and deploy enforcement resources judiciously.

Pursuant to my authority under Reorganization Plan 10, 64 Stat. 1265 (1950), I hereby designate Commissioner Hester Peirce to lead the crypto task force. Commissioner Peirce is thus authorized to direct all of the activities of the task force, including, but not limited to: overseeing the work of agency staff involved in, or otherwise assisting with, the project; seeking input from investors, industry participants, academics, and other interested parties; providing technical assistance to Congress; holding roundtables; and coordinating with federal departments and agencies, and state and international counterparts, among others, as appropriate. In addition, pursuant to the Executive Order entitled *American Leadership in Digital Financial Technology* (Jan. 23, 2025), I hereby designate Commissioner Hester Peirce to serve on the President's Working Group on Digital Asset Markets.
