**ORDER OF CIVIL PENALTIES, AND OTHER EQUITABLE RELIEF AGAINST
STEVEN BREWER, A. MICHAEL JAILLETT AND RICHARD MANN**

This cause coming to be heard on the Motion of the Plaintiff, United States Securities and Exchange Commission ("Commission"), for an Order setting the requested amounts of disgorgement and civil penalties as to Defendants Steven Brewer ("Brewer"), A. Michael Jaillett ("Jaillett"), and Richard Mann ("Mann"), the Court being fully advised in the premises.


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT within ninety (90) days of the entry of Final Judgment: Defendant Brewer shall pay disgorgement and prejudgment interest in the amount of \$651,933; Defendant Jaillett shall pay disgorgement and prejudgment interest in the amount of \$346,689; Defendant Mann shall pay disgorgement and prejudgment interest in the amount of \$2,116,870; representing the realized and unrealized gains from the conduct alleged in the Complaint. Payment of the disgorgement and the prejudgment

interest shall be made payable to the Clerk, U.S. District Court, Southern District of Ohio, by United States Postal money order, certified check, bank cashier's check or bank money order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that pursuant to Section 21A of the Exchange Act [15 U.S.C. §78uA], within ninety (90) days of the entry of Final Judgment, Defendants Brewer, Jaillett and Mann shall pay to the U.S. Treasury civil money penalties in the amount of \$110,000 each. Such payment shall be: (A) made by United States Postal money order, certified check, bank cashier's check or bank money order; (B) made payable to the Securities and Exchange Commission; (C) hand-delivered or mailed to the Comptroller, Securities and Exchange Commission, Operations Center, 6432 General Green Way, Stop 0-3, Alexandria, VA 22312; and (D) submitted under cover letters that identify Steven Brewer, A. Michael Jaillett and Richard Mann as defendants in this matter, the case number of this matter, a copy of which cover letters and money orders of checks shall be sent to Lacey S. Calhoun, Division of Enforcement, Securities and Exchange Commission, Suit 1400, 500 W. Madison Street, Chicago, IL 60661.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that this Court shall retain jurisdiction of this matter for all purposes including, among other things: the implementation and enforcement of the terms and conditions of all orders and decrees that may be entered by this court.
