IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED



5 the name and case number of this action, and the court in which it is pending.
6 Hughes shall simultaneously transmit a copy of the cover letter and the check or
7 money order to SEC counsel at its Los Angeles office, 5670 Wilshire Boulevard,
8 11th Floor, Los Angeles, California 90036;

- 9 2. That plaintiff Securities and Exchange Commission recover its costs of suit herein.
