COMMISSION'S STATUS REPORT REGARDING FINAL JUDGMENT
AGAINST DEFENDANT RAJESH TANEJA

The Court previously entered Judgment against Defendant Rajesh Taneja ("Taneja") that: enjoined him from violations of Sections 5(a) and (c) and 17(a)(1) and (3) of the Securities Act of 1933 and Sections 10(b), 13(d) and 15(a) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rules 10b-5(a) and (c) thereunder, imposed a penny stock bar, ordered him to pay disgorgement of \$837,734 and prejudgment interest of \$109,439.29, and left open the issue of whether he should pay a civil penalty and the amount of that penalty. *See* Dkt. No. 215. In a related matter, the Securities and Exchange Commission (the "Commission") also issued an administrative order barring Taneja from association with any broker, dealer, investment adviser, municipal securities

dealer municipal adviser, transfer agent, or nationally recognized statistical rating organization.

See In the Matter of Rajesh Taneja, AP File No. 3-20157 (Dec. 4, 2020).

The Commission now reports that it is not asking the Court to impose a civil penalty on Taneja in light of his cooperation. Taneja does not oppose this resolution. The Commission does not believe that a new Judgment need be entered against Taneja to reflect the absence of a civil penalty.
