The Court, having considered all the evidence and arguments 28 presented by the parties with regard to the Motion, Plaintiffs' Memorandum of Points and

Authorities in support of the Motion, all other documents filed in support of the Motion, and the record in this action, finds that:

I.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Commission's Renewed Motion for Default Judgment Against Defendant Christopher Byungin Lee is GRANTED.

II.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that Defendant is permanently restrained and enjoined from violating, directly or indirectly, Section 15(a)(1) of the Exchange Act [15 U.S.C. § 78o(a)(1)] by using any means or instrumentality of interstate commerce, or of the mails, or of any facility of any national securities exchange, to effect transactions in, or induce or attempt to induce the purchase or sale of, securities while not registered with the Commission as a broker or dealer or while not associated with an entity registered with the Commission as a broker or dealer.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that, as provided in Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 65(d)(2), the foregoing paragraph also binds the following who receive actual notice of this Judgment by personal service or otherwise:

(a) Defendant's officers, agents, servants, employees, and attorneys; and (b) other persons in active concert or participation with Defendant or with anyone described in (a).

III.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that Defendant is permanently restrained and enjoined from, directly or indirectly, including, but not limited to, through any entity owned or controlled by Defendant, soliciting any person or entity to purchase or sell any security.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that, as provided in Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 65(d)(2), the foregoing paragraph also binds the following who receive actual notice of this Judgment by personal service or otherwise:

collection procedures authorized by law, including the Federal Debt Collection

Procedures Act, 28 U.S.C. § 3001 et seq., and moving for civil contempt for the violation 1 of any Court orders issued in this action. Defendant shall pay post-judgment interest on 2 any amounts due after 30 days of the entry of this Final Judgment pursuant to 28 USC § 3 1961. 4 V. 5 IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that, 6 solely for purposes of exceptions to discharge set forth in Section 523 of the Bankruptcy 7 Code, 11 U.S.C. § 523, the allegations in the complaint are true and admitted by 8 Defendant, and further, any debt for disgorgement, prejudgment interest, civil penalty or 9 other amounts due by Defendant under this Final Judgment or any other judgment, order, 10 consent order, decree or settlement agreement entered in connection with this proceeding, 11 is a debt for the violation by Defendant of the federal securities laws or any regulation or 12 order issued under such laws, as set forth in Section 523(a)(19) of the Bankruptcy Code, 13 11 U.S.C. § 523(a)(19). 14 VI. 15 IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that this 16 Court shall retain jurisdiction of this matter for the purposes of enforcing the terms of this 17 Final Judgment. 18 19 VII.
