9 IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED & DECREED that Freitas and her agents,

12 Final Judgment, by personal service or otherwise, and each of them,
13 are permanently restrained and enjoined from, directly or
14 indirectly:

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16 A. making use of any means or instruments of transportation
17 or communication in interstate commerce or of the mails to
18 sell the securities of any issuer, through the use or
19 medium of any prospectus or otherwise, unless and until a
20 registration statement is in effect as to such securities;

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22 B. carrying or causing to be carried through the mails or in
23 interstate commerce, by any means or instruments of
24 transportation, for the purpose of sale or for delivery
25 after sale, the securities of any issuer, unless and until
26 a registration statement is in effect as to such
27 securities; and

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C. making use of any means or instruments of transportation

26 the use of any means or instruments of transportation or
27 communication in interstate commerce or by the use of the mails:

28 A. employing any device, scheme or artifice to defraud;

1 B. obtaining money or property by means of any untrue
2 statement of a material fact or any omission to state a
3 material fact necessary in order to make the statements
4 made, in the light of the circumstances under which they
5 were made, not misleading; or

6 C. engaging in any transaction, practice, or course of
7 business which operates or would operate as a fraud or
8 deceit upon the purchaser;

9 in violation of Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 [15
10 U.S.C. § 77q(a)].

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III.

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IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Freitas and her
agents, servants, employees and attorneys, and all persons in active
concert or participation with any of them, who receive actual notice
of this Final Judgment by personal service or otherwise, and each of
them, are permanently restrained and enjoined from, directly or
indirectly, in connection with the purchase or sale of any security,
by the use of any means or instrumentality of interstate commerce,
or of the mails, or of any facility of any national securities
exchange:

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- A. employing any device, scheme, or artifice to defraud;
- B. making any untrue statement of a material fact or
omitting to state a material fact necessary in order to
make the statements made, in the light of the
circumstances under which they were made, not misleading;
or
- C. engaging in any act, practice, or course of business

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VI.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that this Court shall retain jurisdiction over this action for all purposes, including to determine the liability of any remaining defendants in this action, to implement and enforce the terms of this Final Judgment and other orders and decrees which may be entered, and to grant such other relief as this Court may deem necessary and just.
