**FINAL DEFAULT JUDGMENT AGAINST THE GLOBUS GROUP, INC.,
AND BRUCE GORCYCA A/K/A ANTHONY DIMARCO**

Pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 55(b), the Court enters this final default judgment for the Securities and Exchange Commission against The Globus Group, Inc., and Bruce Gorcyca a/k/a Anthony DiMarco.

The Globus Group, Inc., and Bruce Gorcyca a/k/a Anthony DiMarco are enjoined from committing any further violations of the securities laws of the United States of America either directly or through an agent.

The Globus Group, Inc., shall disgorge to the SEC \$30,000, for which let execution issue. Bruce Gorcyca a/k/a Anthony DiMarco shall disgorge to the SEC \$225,000, for which let execution issue. In addition, The Globus Group, Inc., shall pay a civil fine to the SEC in the amount of \$75,000, for which let execution issue. Bruce Gorcyca a/k/a Anthony DiMarco shall pay a civil fine to the SEC in the amount of \$75,000, for which let execution issue. The SEC shall remit all money collected pursuant to this final judgment to the United States Treasury.
