I.

The Securities and Exchange Commission (“Commission”) deems it necessary and appropriate for the protection of investors that public administrative proceedings be, and hereby are, instituted pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (“Exchange Act”).

II.

After an investigation, the Division of Enforcement alleges that:

A. RESPONDENTS

1. Geographics, Inc. (n/k/a G Printing, Inc.) (“Geographics”) (CIK No. 1000621) is a void Delaware corporation located in Waukesha, Wisconsin with a class of equity securities registered with the Commission pursuant to Exchange Act Section 12(g). Geographics is delinquent in its periodic filings with the Commission, having not filed any periodic reports since it filed a Form 10-Q for the period ended December 31, 2001, which reported a \$1.7 million net loss for the prior nine months. On September 17, 2002, the company changed its name to G Printing, Inc., but failed to record this change with the Commission as required by Commission rules. As of September 25, 2006, the company’s common stock (symbol “GGIT”) was quoted on the Pink Sheets, had five market makers, and was eligible for the piggyback exemption of Exchange Act Rule 15c2-11(f)(3).

2. Pembroke Capital, Inc. (“Pembroke”) (CIK No. 842706) is a revoked Nevada corporation located in Vancouver, British Columbia, Canada with a class of

equity securities registered with the Commission pursuant to Exchange Act Section 12(g). Pembroke is delinquent in its periodic filings with the Commission, having not filed any periodic reports since it filed a Form 10-QSB for the period ended September 30, 1995, which reported a \$4.4 million deficit since inception and a net loss of \$343,594 for the prior three months.

3. Window Rock Capital Corp. (n/k/a Window Rock Capital Holdings, Inc.) (“Window Rock”) (CIK No. 1001808) is a defaulted Nevada corporation located in The Woodlands, Texas with a class of equity securities registered with the Commission pursuant to Exchange Act Section 12(g). Window Rock is delinquent in its periodic filings with the Commission, having filed only one Form 10-QSB in the last three years. Window Rock filed (three months late) a Form 10-QSB for the period ended September 30, 2005, which reported no revenue and a net loss of \$138,378 for the prior three months. This filing also identified the company by the name Window Rock Capital Holdings, Inc., the same name listed in the Nevada Secretary of State records, but the company failed to record the name change with the Commission as required by Commission rules. Prior to filing this Form 10-QSB, Window Rock failed to file two annual reports and six quarterly reports. After the filing of this Form 10-QSB for the period ended September 30, 2005, Window Rock failed to file one annual report and one quarterly report. As of September 25, 2006, the company’s common stock (symbol “WRKC”) was quoted on the Pink Sheets, had sixteen market makers, and was eligible for the piggyback exemption of Exchange Act Rule 15c2-11(f)(3).

B. DELINQUENT PERIODIC FILINGS

4. As discussed in more detail above, all of the respondents are delinquent in their periodic filings with the Commission (*see* Chart of Delinquent Filings, attached hereto as Appendix 1), have repeatedly failed to meet their obligations to file timely periodic reports, and failed to heed delinquency letters sent to them by the Division of Corporation Finance requesting compliance with their periodic filing obligations or, through their failure to maintain a valid address on file with the Commission as required by Commission rule, did not receive such letters.

5. Exchange Act Section 13(a) and the rules promulgated thereunder require issuers of securities registered pursuant to Exchange Act Section 12 to file with the Commission current and accurate information in periodic reports, even if the registration is voluntary under Section 12(g). Specifically, Rule 13a-1 requires issuers to file annual reports (Forms 10-K or 10-KSB), and Rule 13a-13 requires issuers to file quarterly reports (Forms 10-Q or 10-QSB).

6. As a result of the foregoing, Respondents failed to comply with Exchange Act Section 13(a) and Rules 13a-1 and 13a-13 thereunder.

III.

In view of the allegations made by the Division of Enforcement, the Commission deems it necessary and appropriate for the protection of investors that public administrative proceedings be instituted to determine:

A. Whether the allegations contained in Section II are true and, in connection therewith, to afford the Respondents an opportunity to establish any defenses to such allegations; and,

B. Whether it is necessary and appropriate for the protection of investors to suspend for a period not exceeding twelve months or revoke the registration of each class of securities of the Respondents identified in Section II registered pursuant to Section 12 of the Exchange Act.

IV.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that a public hearing for the purpose of taking evidence on the questions set forth in Section III hereof shall be convened at a time and place to be fixed, and before an Administrative Law Judge to be designated by further order as provided by Rule 110 of the Commission's Rules of Practice [17 C.F.R. § 201.110].

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Respondents shall file an Answer to the allegations contained in this Order within ten (10) days after service of this Order, as provided by Rule 220(b) of the Commission's Rules of Practice [17 C.F.R. § 201.220(b)].

If Respondents fail to file the directed Answers, or fail to appear at a hearing after being duly notified, the Respondents may be deemed in default and the proceedings may be determined against them upon consideration of this Order, the allegations of which may be deemed to be true as provided by Rules 155(a), 220(f), 221(f), and 310 of the Commission's Rules of Practice [17 C.F.R. §§ 201.155(a), 201.220(f), 201.221(f), and 201.310].

This Order shall be served forthwith upon Respondents personally or by certified, registered, or Express Mail, or by other means of verifiable delivery.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrative Law Judge shall issue an initial decision no later than 120 days from the date of service of this Order, pursuant to Rule 360(a)(2) of the Commission's Rules of Practice [17 C.F.R. § 201.360(a)(2)].

In the absence of an appropriate waiver, no officer or employee of the Commission engaged in the performance of investigative or prosecuting functions in this or any factually related proceeding will be permitted to participate or advise in the decision of this matter, except as witness or counsel in proceedings held pursuant to notice. Since this proceeding is not “rule making” within the meaning of Section 551 of the Administrative Procedure Act, it is not deemed subject to the provisions of Section 553 delaying the effective date of any final Commission action.
