NOTICE THAT INITIAL DECISION HAS BECOME FINAL

The time for filing a petition for review of the initial decision in this proceeding has expired. No such petition has been filed by Hall Tees, Inc., Hosokawa Micron International, Inc., James River Coal Company, Napa Sonoma Group, Inc. (f/k/a Andes 1, Inc.), or Self Change Corporation and the Commission has not chosen to review the decision on its own initiative.

Accordingly, notice is hereby given, pursuant to Rule 360(d) of the Commission's Rules of Practice,¹ that the initial decision of the administrative law judge has become the final decision of the Commission with respect to Hall Tees, Inc., Hosokawa Micron International, Inc., James River Coal Company, Napa Sonoma Group, Inc. (f/k/a Andes 1, Inc.), and Self Change Corporation.² The order contained in that decision is hereby declared final. The initial decision ordered that, pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, the registrations of each class of registered securities of Hall Tees, Inc., Hosokawa Micron
