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**DECLARATION OF GINA JOYCE**  
**TO ASSIST SECRETARY WITH RECORD OF SERVICE**

GINA JOYCE, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1746, declares:

1. I am Staff Counsel with the Division of Enforcement (“Division”) of the Securities and Exchange Commission, and co-counsel for the Division in the above-captioned administrative proceeding. I am submitting this Declaration to assist the Secretary in maintaining a record of service of the Order Instituting Proceedings (“OIP”) on the respondent, Ionix Technology, Inc. (“IINX” or “Respondent”), in the captioned proceeding pursuant to Rule of Practice 141(a)(3).

2. The address shown in IINX’s last filing with the Commission, an 8-K filed on March 22, 2023, was in the People’s Republic of China (“China”). *See* Exhibit 1 (a true copy of the face page of the 8-K filed on March 22, 2023). Though China is a signatory to the Hague Convention on the Service Abroad of Judicial and Extrajudicial Documents (“Hague Convention”), 20 U.S.T. 361, T.I.A.S. 6638, 658 U.N.T.A. 163 (1964), it objects to service by mail under Article 10(a). Thus, in order to perfect service on IINX in China, the Division would be required to have the document

translated into Chinese and request the assistance of the Central Authority of China, a process which could delay service by more than a year. Therefore, the Division chose to first attempt service by means other than through the Hague Convention.

3. Although its last address is in China, IINX is a Nevada corporation. A search of the website of the Nevada Secretary of State revealed that name and address of IINX's registered agent are InCorp Services, Inc., 3773 Howard Hughes Parkway, Suite 500S, Las Vegas, Nevada 89169 – 6014. A true copy of a printout of the first page of IINX's corporate status page from that website is attached hereto as Exhibit 2.

Therefore, the Division provided this address to the Office of the Secretary and requested that the Secretary attempt service on IINX's Nevada registered agent via U.S. Priority Mail Express. The Secretary mailed the OIP to IINX's registered agent at the address referenced above via U.S. Certified Mail, Tracking No. 7016 0910 0001 6656 0125. My search of the USPS tracking system, at [www.usps.com](http://www.usps.com), confirmed that the OIP package was delivered on March 6, 2024. A true copy of the tracking confirmation is attached hereto as Exhibit 3.

I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct.
