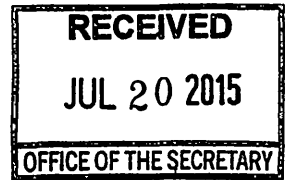

RESPONDENT ANDREW G. GUZZETTI'S
MOTION FOR ORAL ARGUMENT


Pursuant to Rule 451 of the Securities and Exchange Commission's Rules of Practice, Respondent Andrew G. Guzzetti ("Guzzetti") respectfully submits this motion for oral argument before the Commission in this matter. Rule 451 provides that Oral Argument is appropriate where "the presentation of facts and legal arguments in the brief and record and the decisional process would be significantly aided by oral argument." 17 C.F.R. § 201.451(a).

This is a very complex case involving 10 separate respondents and a number of complex legal issues. Guzzetti is the only Respondent to be alleged to have had supervisory duties in relation to the transactions at issue. As a result, there are a number of issues which relate directly Guzzetti alone. As a result, oral argument would greatly aid the decisional process by providing Guzzetti with the opportunity to address those issues that affect the separate and distinct allegations against him.

For these reasons, Andrew G. Guzzetti respectfully requests that his Motion for Oral Argument be granted.
