

Addenda to "Motion for Court re Feathers 3-15755"

- (1) to Clarify as to 30, 75, or 120 Day Proceeding Under Rule 250**
- (2) To clarify as to any "good cause shown" by either of the parties in these proceedings**
- (3) Consideration that Respondent has been prevented from presenting facts essential to justify opposition to Enforcement's Motion**
- (4) Rule 323 Evidence and Official Notice"**

Respondent has raised issues in his motion as to ripeness in the timing of motion filing for summary disposition, and to the failure of parties to adhere to procedural requirements of SEC Rules of Practice. Respondent adds this addenda to his motion to ensure that the court understands that Respondent anticipates full opportunity to respond - with more fully developed comments - to Enforcement's anticipated motion for leave to file a motion for summary disposition, not just those issues outlined in Respondent's motion on this date, when the court directs Enforcement to adhere to the Commission's Rules of Practice.
