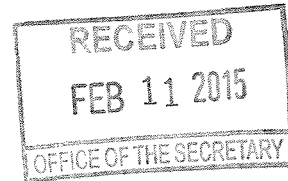

**JOINT MOTION TO STAY
HEARING PURSUANT TO RULE
161(c)(2)**



Pursuant to Rule 161(c)(2) of the Commission's Rules of Practice, 17 C.F.R. § 201.161(c)(2), the Division of Enforcement ("Division") and Respondent Jerome Kaiser ("Kaiser"), by counsel, respectfully move for a stay of the hearing as to Respondent Kaiser scheduled to commence on February 23, 2015, based upon the agreement in principle to a settlement on all major terms between the Division and Respondent Kaiser.

On February 9, 2015, counsel for the Division and counsel for Kaiser reached an agreement in principle to a settlement on all major terms, in a mediation before the Honorable Jason S. Patil. Therefore, the parties jointly request a stay of this proceeding as to Respondent Kaiser, pursuant to Rule of Practice 161(c)(2). Rule 161(c)(2) provides that upon filing of a joint motion notifying the hearing officer that the Division and one or more respondents have reached an agreement in principle on all major terms, the hearing officer shall grant a stay of the


