On December 20, 2021, the Division of Enforcement (the “Division”) and Respondents The Robare Group, Ltd., Mark L. Robare, and Jack L. Jones, Jr. filed a Joint Motion to Stay, pursuant to Rule 161(c)(2) of the Commission’s Rules of Practice, to apprise the Commission that the parties had reached an agreement in principle to settle this matter. *See* Dec. 20, 2021 Joint Motion to Stay. The parties requested that the Commission stay this proceeding to allow time for the parties to memorialize the agreement and for the Division to submit signed Offers to the Commission for its consideration. *Id.*

Today, the parties file this Joint Notice of Non-Settlement to apprise the Commission that the parties have been unable to finalize an agreement and that there is no longer an agreement in principle to settle this matter. As such, the parties request that the Commission issue an Opinion in this matter.


