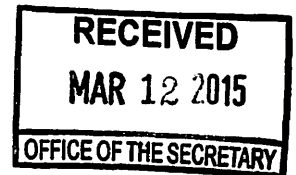

**JOINT MOTION BY THE DIVISION OF ENFORCEMENT AND
RESPONDENT JOHN JORDAN FOR STAY PENDING COMMISSION
CONSIDERATION OF OFFER OF SETTLEMENT**

The Division of Enforcement (“Division”) and Respondent John Jordan (“Respondent” or “Mr. Jordan”) hereby notify the Court they they have agreed in principle to a settlement on all major terms in this matter. The Division and Respondent therefore request that, pursuant to Rule 161 of the Commission’s Rules of Practice, 17 C.F.R. § 201.161, that the Court stay these proceedings as to Mr. Jordan.

The Commission and Respondent will work diligently to meet the deadlines set out in Rule 161 for submitting a signed offer of settlement, and for submitting the settlement offer and accompanying recommendation to the Commission for consideration. The parties note, however, that Mr. Jordan remains incarcerated in federal custody. He has been moved between the custody of the U.S. Marshal Service and the Bureau of Prisons several times because of transportation for court hearings. The Division and counsel for Mr. Jordan have agreed upon the language of the offer and hope that there are not significant issues obtaining a notarized signature from Mr. Jordan. We

will advise the Court if logistical issues are encountered that make meeting the 15 business day requirement set out in Rule 161(c)(2)(A) a problem.

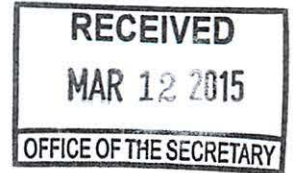


