DIVISION OF ENFORCEMENT'S STATUS REPORT REGARDING SERVICE OF THE ORDER INSTITUTING PROCEEDINGS

The Division of Enforcement ("Division") hereby provides a status report regarding service of the Order Instituting Proceedings (OIP) in this matter.

On October 17, 2014, the Division sent, by certified mail, the OIP to Mr. Reda directly. He currently is incarcerated at the U.S. Penitentiary, USP Lompoc, in Lompoc, California. The Division requested return receipt as to that mailing, which it received on November 12, 2014. The return receipt indicated that the registered mailing had been received and signed for at USP Lompoc on November 6, 2014. A copy of the Return Receipt is attached hereto.


On November 17, 2014 I spoke with the Case Manager for Mr. Reda at the Lompoc facility, Tracy DuBose. Ms. DuBose advised me that procedures at Lompoc ensure that mail received at the facility is delivered to an inmate within twenty-four hours, which means Mr. Reda received the OIP no later than November 7, 2014.

Ms. DuBose also advised me that the Lompoc facility has the capability for telephonic conferences for inmates, but requested at least 7 days notice so that the necessary arrangement can be made.
