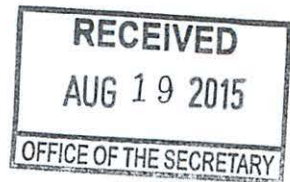

MOTION BY DIVISION OF
ENFORCEMENT UNDER RULE OF
PRACTICE 111 TO CONFORM
ORDER TO SANCTIONS SECTION OF
INITIAL DECISION

On August 17, 2015, the Initial Decision was issued in this matter. At the close of the findings regarding imposition of a “Collateral Bar and Cease-and- Desist Order” in the “Sanctions” section of the Initial Decision, the Initial Decision concludes that:

Given these facts, I find that Eldaher should be: (1) suspended from association and from participating in an offering of penny stock for six months. . . .

Initial Decision at 13. In contrast, the Order at the conclusion of the Initial Decision orders the Respondent suspended for three months. *Id.* at 14.

The Division respectfully moves, pursuant to Rule of Practice 111, that the Order be corrected to conform to the Sanctions section of the Initial Decision.
