DIVISION OF ENFORCEMENT'S AND RESPONDENT'S JOINT MOTION TO STAY

Pursuant to Commission Rule of Practice ("Rule") 161(c)(2)(ii)(C), the Division of Enforcement (the "Division") and Respondent Nicholas Toms ("Toms") hereby respectfully jointly move for a stay in this proceeding against Toms. The Division has now received a signed settlement offer from Toms and will submit it to the Commission.

On February 23, 2015, the Division and Respondent Nicholas Toms ("Respondent") jointly filed a motion to stay this proceeding after both parties agreed to a settlement in principle. The same day, the Court granted the motion and issued a Stay Order. On March 10, 2015, the Division provided Respondent with draft settlement papers. Rule 161(c)(2)(A) required Respondent to submit a signed settlement offer to the Division by March 16, 2015. On March 17, 2015, the Division notified the Court that the parties were in negotiations regarding the settlement papers and that Respondent was therefore unable to timely provide the Division with a signed offer of settlement. The stay then lapsed, and the Court set a pre-hearing conference for the afternoon of Thursday, March 26, 2015.

On Monday, March 23, 2015, the Division received a signed settlement offer from Toms. The Division intends to submit the offer to the Commission and shall notify the Court promptly if the Commission rejects the offer.
