

DIVISION OF ENFORCEMENT'S MOTION FOR ADJOURNMENT OF HEARING AND FOR SCHEDULING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

On February 13, 2015, the Commission issued an Order Instituting Administrative and Cease-and-Desist Proceedings Pursuant to Section 8A of the Securities Act of 1933, Sections 4C and 21C of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, and Rule 102(e) of the Commission Rules of Practice ("OIP") against Respondents Traci J. Anderson, CPA, Timothy W. Carnahan and Cyios Corporation.

On February 18, 2015, Chief Administrative Law Judge Brenda P. Murray, ordered a hearing in this matter to commence on March 23, 2015, and directed the parties to confer and notify the presiding judge of a suggested date and time for a prehearing conference.

The Division moves for an order setting aside the March 23, 2015, hearing, and, in lieu thereof, for an order scheduling a telephonic prehearing conference for March 23, 2015, or other date at the convenience of the Court. The Respondents agree to this request.

Postponing the hearing date and scheduling a prehearing conference will allow the Court to establish an orderly and efficient prehearing schedule, including a mutually acceptable date for a hearing. The Division will arrange for the telephone call.
