ANSWER AND MOTION TO
DISMISS

Respondent Liberty Petroleum Corporation ("LPC") submits this **Answer and Motion to Dismiss** to the "Order Instituting Administrative Proceedings and Notice of
Hearing Pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934" ("OIAP"),
dated July 8, 2015, pursuant to Rules 154 and 220 of the Commission's Rules of Practice.
Ballard Spahr LLP's Notice of Appearance, on behalf of LPC, and pursuant to Rule 102
of the Commission's Rules of Practice, is being submitted with this filing.

LPC is serving the original and three copies to the Commission's Secretary via

FedEx and emailing copies to SEC Senior Counsel, David S. Frye (by agreement) and to

the Administrative Law Judge and the Judge's Legal Assistant.

LPC denies the allegations contained in the OIAP. LPC is not delinquent in the filing of any periodic filings or reports or as otherwise alleged in the OIAP. No violation of any SEC Statute, Rule or Regulation has occurred.

#### LPC's 1987 Exemption Order

On August 25, 1987 the Commission issued an Order (Rel. No. 34-24851) granting LPC's request for an exemption from the registration requirement of Section 12(g) and the reporting requirement of Section 15(d) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. A copy of Release No. 34-24851 is attached as *Exhibit 1*. On Friday, July 17, 2015, undersigned counsel for LPC spoke with the SEC's Senior Counsel, David S. Frye, informing Mr. Frye of the Exemption Order and communicated the same information to Mr. Frye via email. A copy of LPC's July 17, 2015, email with exhibit to Mr. Frye is attached as *Exhibit 2*. Counsel and Mr. Frye remain in continuing professional and goodfaith discussions regarding this matter.

Unless otherwise expressly admitted, the allegations contained in the OIAP against LPC are denied. LPC also moves for an order dismissing the OIAP and matter on the grounds that the OIAP does not state a viable or facial claim against LPC, in light of the 1987 Exemption Order.

LPC respectfully requests that the matter be dismissed and taken off of the hearing calendar currently set for hearing on July 29, 2015. Alternatively, LPC requests that the

hearing be postponed until LPC can be apprised of the Staff's position regarding the 1987 Exemption Order and has a reasonable time to prepare for any necessary hearing.

#### **ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS**

SANCTIONS IMPOSED ON MAX EDWARD ZAVANELLI

The Commission ordered public administrative proceedings under Sections 203(e) and 203(f) of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940 against Max Edward Zavanelli (Zavanelli) and Max Edward Zavanelli d/b/a Zavanelli Portfolio Research, a registered investment adviser. The Order alleges that Zavanelli, from in or about March 1984 and continuing through the present, violated the antifraud provisions of the Advisers Act, by misstating and omitting to state material facts concerning, among other things, his investment performance. As part of his alleged violative conduct, Zavanelli failed to disclose that his average investment "performance" for a seven year period included at least three years during which no actual trading occurred and the purported "results" were from hypothetical portfolios. Zavanelli consented to the Order censuring him, prohibiting him from soliciting or accepting new clients for a period of 180 days and requiring Zavanelli to notify his clients of the Commission's action. In addition, Zavanelli consented to remedial undertakings specified in the Commission's Order. (Rel. IA-1077)

OFFER OF SETTLEMENT ACCEPTED FROM CITIWIDE SECURITIES CORP. AND HERBERT CANNON

The New York Regional Office announced that, in administrative proceedings ordered pursuant to Sections 15(b) and 19(h) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, Citiwide Securities Corp. (Registrant), a registered broker-dealer located in New York, New York, and its president, Herbert Cannon, have submitted Offers of Settlement which the Commission has accepted. Registrant and Cannon, without admitting or denying the allegations, consented to the issuance of an Order Making Findings and Imposing Remedial Sanctions which finds that Registrant wilfully violated, and Cannon wilfully aided and abetted Registrant's violations of, the Net Capital, Recordkeeping, Financial Reporting and Supplemental Reporting provisions of the Exchange Act. The Commission revoked Registrant's registration as a broker or dealer, investment company, investment adviser or municipal securities dealer, with a right to reapply after the greater of five years or the period of any penal sanction that may be imposed in connection with two unrelated criminal convictions.
