The Division opposes the request on the grounds that there is no provision in the Commission's Rules of practice for a sur-reply, but more importantly, a sur-reply is neither warranted nor necessary to deciding the matters raised by the Division's motion.

To prevail on this proceeding, the Division must establish that: (1) Price has been enjoined from violating the federal securities laws, and (2) it is in the public interest to impose a bar against him. The Division met that burden in its motion for summary disposition. In his opposition brief, Price conceded that the allegations relevant to the Division's motion for summary disposition are true (Opp. at Section I.B, p. 4), but raised certain items which he argues mitigate against a bar, including is pending FINRA arbitration and his purported cooperation with the SEC and compliance with the underlying judgment against him. The Division rebutted Price's specious claims in its reply brief, and now Price seeks to proffer his own self-serving deposition testimony and declaration in response. The Division respectfully submits that Price's unjustified sur-reply does not in fact rebut the statements made in the Division's reply and the Supplemental Declaration of Lynn M. Dean, is irrelevant to the disposition of the Division's pending motion, and should not be considered.
