

DIVISION OF ENFORCEMENT'S MOTION FOR PARTIAL SUMMARY DISPOSITION AGAINST BIOELECTRONICS CORP.

The Division of Enforcement ("Division"), pursuant to Rule 250 of the Commission's Rules of Practice, moves for an order of summary disposition on the non-scienter based reporting violation claims raised against respondent BioElectronics Corp. ("BioElectronics or BIEL"). As there is no genuine issue with regard to any material fact, the Division is entitled to summary disposition as a matter of law on its claims against BIEL for violating Section 13(a) of the Securities and Exchange Act of 1934 ("Exchange Act") [15 U.S.C. § 78m(a)], and Rule 13a-1 thereunder [C.F.R. 240.13a-1].

In support of this Motion, the Division relies upon the accompanying Memorandum of Law and exhibits attached thereto. The Division respectfully requests that the Court grant this motion.
