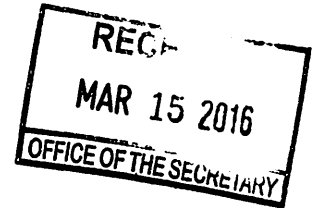

Respondents deny that the Commission is entitled to any remedial action alleged in Paragraphs A and B of Paragraph III.


IV.


