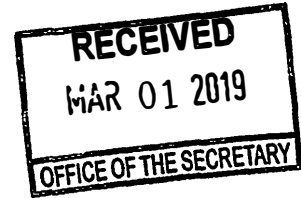



LEGAL NOTICE

TO: China Linen Textile Industry, Ltd. and Huixin Wastewater Solutions, Inc.

You are each a respondent in separate administrative proceedings (“APs”) brought by the United States Securities and Exchange Commission (the “Commission”). The Commission alleged in separate Orders Instituting Proceedings (“OIPs”) that you have a class of securities registered with the Commission pursuant to Exchange Act Section 12(g), and that you are delinquent in your periodic filings with the Commission, having not filed any periodic reports in several years. Accordingly, each of you failed to comply with Exchange Act Section 13(a) and Rules 13a-1 and 13a-13 thereunder.

Each AP’s purpose is to find whether it is necessary and appropriate for the protection of investors to suspend for a period not exceeding twelve months, or revoke, the registration of each class of your securities registered pursuant to Section 12 of the Exchange Act. If revocation or suspension is ordered, it will preclude any U.S. broker, dealer, or national securities exchange, from executing trades in the affected securities either permanently or for a period not exceeding twelve months as the order may provide.


