Subject: Request for Reinstatement – Robert Arthur Wilson (CRD #1447213)

Dear Commissioners,

I am writing to respectfully request that the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission reconsider and reinstate Mr. Robert Arthur Wilson (CRD #1447213), who was previously subject to a permanent bar from association with any broker, dealer, or investment adviser.

Mr. Wilson has been instrumental in exposing a significant case of securities fraud that involved high-profile individuals and institutions. His actions, which included bringing forward credible evidence, were pivotal in triggering investigations that ultimately led to criminal cases being brought against four defendants. Notably, his disclosures included allegations of securities-related misconduct implicating then-President Barack Obama.

The nature of Mr. Wilson's cooperation, and the ensuing legal outcomes, merit a second review of his current barred status. While we acknowledge the gravity of past infractions that led to his disqualification, it is equally important to recognize the value of his whistleblowing efforts in safeguarding market integrity and protecting investors. The Commission has a long-standing commitment to encouraging transparency and rewarding those who expose systemic wrongdoing.

Given Mr. Wilson's contribution to the enforcement of securities laws, and his demonstrated commitment to upholding ethical standards, I respectfully urge the Commission to re-evaluate the lifetime ban and consider granting his petition for reinstatement. His knowledge, experience, and integrity could again serve the public and the securities industry under the proper oversight and conditions.
