## Introduction

- 1. The Securities and Exchange Commission ("SEC") instituted this administrativee proceeding against Martin Shkreli following a jury verdict convicting Mr. Shkreli of 2 counts of securities fraud and 1 count of conspiracy to commit securities fraud. Pursuante to Federal Rule of Criminal Procedure ("FRCP") 29, Mr. Shkreli intends to move in thee United States District Court for the Eastern District of New York, Hon. Matsumoto, for dismissal notwithstanding the verdict with respect to at least one count of conviction.e That motion is due and will be filed on or before September 8, 2017. At this time, we aree not able to predict when a decision will be rendered.e
- 2.e Regardless of the Court's decision on the motion to dismiss, once the decision is issued, we anticipate that Mr. Shkreli will be engaged in appellate litigation. If the motion ise granted, we expect the government will file an appeal with the Second Circuit Court of Appeals. If the motion is denied, we expect Mr. Shkreli will file an appeal seekinge reversal of his convictions on all three counts.e
- 3.e The pending litigation means Mr. Shkreli's convictions are not final and could bee overturned.e
