RESPONDENT JENNIFER F. WOLF'S PETITION TO LIFT TEMPORARY SUSPENSION PURSUANT TO RULE 102(e)(3)(i)(A) OF THE COMMISSION'S RULES OF PRACTICE

I. INTRODUCTION

Respondent Jennifer F. Wolf, through undersigned counsel, hereby files this petition with the Securities and Exchange Commission ("Commission") to lift the temporary suspension imposed on her from appearing or practicing before the Commission pursuant to Rule 102(e)(3)(ii) of the Commission's Rules of Practice.

II. DISCUSSION

On September 14, 2018, the Commission issued an order instituting public administrative proceedings against Ms. Wolf pursuant to Rule 102(e)(3)(i)(A) (the "Order"). The Order temporarily suspended Ms. Wolf from appearing or practicing before the Commission pursuant to Rule 102(e)(3)(i)(A).

By its terms, the Order provides that the temporary suspension shall be effective upon service of the Order on Ms. Wolf. A copy of the Order was served by certified mail on counsel for Ms. Wolf on September 21, 2018.

The Order further provides that if Ms. Wolf files a petition with the Commission to lift the temporary suspension within thirty days after service of the Order, the Commission shall, within thirty days after the filing of the petition, lift the temporary suspension and set a briefing schedule pursuant to Rule 250.

III. CONCLUSION

For all the foregoing reasons, Ms. Wolf respectfully requests that the Commission immediately lift the temporary suspension and set a briefing schedule in this proceeding pursuant to Rule 250.
