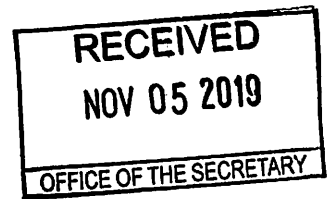

**DIVISION OF ENFORCEMENT'S MOTION FOR
DEFAULT AND BRIEF IN SUPPORT**

The Division of Enforcement (“Division”), by counsel, pursuant to Commission Rules of Practice Rules 154(a) and 155(a)(2) respectfully moves the Securities and Exchange Commission (“Commission”) for an order entering a default against Shenzhen Yidian Double Way of Innovation Culture Media Corp. (CIK No. 1479382) (“SYDW” or “Respondent”) in this proceeding and ordering the revocation of the registration of each class of SYDW’s securities registered pursuant to Section 12 of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (“Exchange Act”).

Argument

On July 23, 2019, the Commission issued an Order Instituting Proceedings (“OIP”) against SYDW¹ which has securities registered with the Commission under Section 12(g) of the Exchange Act. The OIP alleges that SYDW is delinquent in filing its mandated periodic reports. Because SYDW failed to answer or otherwise respond to the OIP, the Division now seeks entry of an order finding respondent SYDW to be in default in this proceeding.

¹ The other Respondent named in the OIP, QuantumSphere, Inc., settled with the Commission and is no longer a party to this proceeding. *See* Exchange Act Rel. No. 86801 (August 28, 2019).

Commission Rule of Practice 220(b) states that where an answer is required to be filed by rule or order, the respondent “shall do so within 20 days after service upon the respondent of the order instituting proceedings” unless a different period is provided by rule or order. Here, the OIP requires “an Answer [to be filed] to the allegations contained in this Order within ten (10) days after service of this Order.” OIP at IV. Commission Rule of Practice 160(a) provides that Saturdays, Sundays and Federal legal holidays are to be counted as part of the 10 day period, and Commission Rule of Practice 160(b) extends that time by three days if service is made by mail.

The Declaration of Gina Joyce to Assist Secretary with Record of Service (attached hereto as Exhibit A) establishes that between July 25, 2019 and July 29, 2019, service upon SYDW of the OIP, along with a letter from the Commission’s Secretary, and a letter from the Division offering discovery pursuant to Rule of Practice 230, was attempted by Express Mail delivery at the address provided in SYDW’s last EDGAR filing with the Commission, in accordance with Commission Rule of Practice 141(a)(2)(ii). SYDW’s answer was due by Monday, August 12, 2019. However, SYDW has not filed an answer or made any other response to the OIP in this proceeding.

The Respondent at issue is delinquent in its filings with the Commission and has been delinquent for over two years. In addition, the Respondent’s failure to answer supports revocation of the registration of each class of Respondent’s securities. Accordingly, the Division moves for an order, pursuant to Rule 155(a)(2), finding this Respondent to be in default in this proceeding and ordering that the registration of each class of its securities registered pursuant to Exchange Act Section 12 be revoked.


Conclusion

For the reasons set forth above, the Division respectfully requests that the Commission:

1) grant the Division's Motion; 2) enter an order of default against SYDW; and 3) revoke the registration of each class of its securities registered pursuant to Section 12 of the Exchange Act.

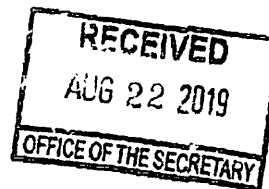

**DECLARATION OF GINA JOYCE
TO ASSIST SECRETARY WITH RECORD OF SERVICE**

GINA JOYCE, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1746, declares:

1. I am a Senior Counsel with the Division of Enforcement (“Division”) of the Securities and Exchange Commission, and co-counsel for the Division in the captioned administrative proceeding. I am submitting this Declaration to assist the Secretary in maintaining a record of service on the respondents in the captioned proceedings pursuant to Rule 141(a)(3).

2. Among other means, Securities and Exchange Commission (“Commission”) Rule of Practice 141(a)(2)(ii) permits service on a corporation or entity by delivering a copy of an Order Instituting Administrative Proceedings (“OIP”) to an agent authorized by appointment or law to receive such service or, in the case of an issuer with a class of securities registered with the Commission, by sending the OIP via U.S. Postal Service certified, registered, or Express Mail and obtaining a confirmation of attempted delivery on the most recent address shown on the entity’s most recent filing with the Commission.

Further, the OIP in this matter authorizes service of the OIP “by any means permitted by the Commission’s Rules of Practice.” Therefore, the Division asked the Commission’s Secretary to first attempt service on the Respondents via U.S. Priority Mail Express.

3. The Office of the Secretary provided me with the U.S. Priority Mail Express tracking numbers for the copies of the Order Instituting Proceedings (“OIP”)¹ that were mailed by the Secretary to the respondents in these proceedings. I input each of the tracking numbers into the U.S. Postal Service’s (“USPS’s”) package tracking system on its Internet website located at www.usps.com, and printed out the tracking confirmations in order to obtain confirmation of the delivery or attempted delivery of the OIP on each respondent. A true copy of the tracking confirmations for all of the respondents for whom express mail service was attempted is attached as Exhibit 1, hereto.

4. The Secretary mailed the OIP to respondent QuantumSphere, Inc., CIK 1387135 (“QSIM”), via Priority Mail Express, Tracking No. EF 200199114 US, to the address shown on its most recent EDGAR filing at 2 Park Plaza, Suite 1200, Irvine, CA 92614. This address is taken from QSIM’s last filing with the Commission, which was a Form 8-K filed with the Commission on July 17, 2019. The USPS tracking system confirms that the package was delivered on July 25, 2019. *See* Exhibit 1 at p. 1.


5. The Secretary mailed the OIP to respondent Shenzhen Yidian Double Way of Innovation Culture Media Corp., CIK 1479382 (“SYDW”), via Priority Mail Express, Tracking No. EF 200199088 US, to the address shown on its most recent EDGAR filing at 136-20 38th Avenue, #3G, Flushing, NY 11354. This address is taken from SYDW’s last filing with the Commission, which was a Form 8-K filed with the Commission on

April 27, 2017. The USPS tracking system confirms that delivery was first attempted on July 25, 2019. The package was then forwarded to another address where delivery was attempted on July 29, 2019. It was determined that the addressee had moved and left no other address. The package was returned to the SEC.. See Exhibit 1 at pp. 4 - 5.


