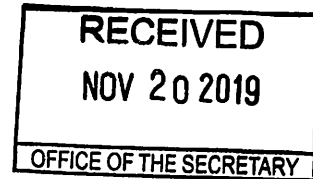

**DIVISION OF ENFORCEMENT'S MOTION FOR**  
**DEFAULT AND BRIEF IN SUPPORT**

The Division of Enforcement (“Division”), by counsel, pursuant to Commission Rules of Practice Rules 154(a) and 155(a)(2) respectfully moves the Securities and Exchange Commission (“Commission”) for an order entering a default against EMTA Corp. a/k/a Wiltex A (CIK No. 1171878) (“EMTA”), Fuzzy Logic Software Corp. a/k/a China Global Solar Corporation Limited (CIK No. 1098799) (“Fuzzy Logic”), and Granite Futures Fund Limited Partnership (CIK No. 882257) (“Granite Futures”) (collectively “Respondents”) in this proceeding and ordering the revocation of the registration of each class of Respondents’ securities registered pursuant to Section 12 of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (“Exchange Act”).

**Argument**

On September 23, 2019, the Commission issued an Order Instituting Proceedings (“OIP”) against Respondents which have securities registered with the Commission under Section 12(g) of the Exchange Act. The OIP alleges the Respondents are delinquent in filing

their mandated periodic reports. Because each of the Respondents failed to answer or otherwise respond to the OIP, the Division now seeks entry of an order finding respondents EMTA, Fuzzy Logic, and Granite Futures to be in default in this proceeding.

Commission Rule of Practice 220(b) states that where an answer is required to be filed by rule or order, the respondent “shall do so within 20 days after service upon the respondent of the order instituting proceedings” unless a different period is provided by rule or order. Here, the OIP requires “an Answer [to be filed] to the allegations contained in this Order within ten (10) days after service of this Order.” OIP at IV. Commission Rule of Practice 160(a) provides that Saturdays, Sundays and Federal legal holidays are to be counted as part of the 10 day period, and Commission Rule of Practice 160(b) extends that time by three days if service is made by mail.

The Declaration of Gina Joyce to Assist Secretary with Record of Service (attached hereto as Exhibit A) (“Joyce Declaration”) establishes that on September 24, 2019, service upon EMTA of the OIP, along with a letter from the Commission’s Secretary, and a letter from the Division offering discovery pursuant to Rule of Practice 230 (collectively the “Service Documents”), was attempted by Express Mail delivery at the address provided in its last EDGAR filing with the Commission, in accordance with Commission Rule of Practice 141(a)(2)(ii). EMTA’s answer to the OIP was due by Monday, October 7, 2019. However, EMTA has neither filed an answer nor made any other response to the OIP in this proceeding.

The Joyce Declaration also establishes that on October 9, 2019, service upon Fuzzy Logic of the Service Documents was attempted by Registered Mail at the address provided in its last EDGAR filing with the Commission, in accordance with Commission Rule of Practice 141(a)(2)(ii). Fuzzy Logic’s answer to the OIP was due by Tuesday, October 22, 2019.

However, Fuzzy Logic has neither filed an answer nor made any other response to the OIP in this proceeding.

The Joyce Declaration additionally establishes that on September 24, 2019, service upon Granite Futures of the Service Documents was attempted by Express Mail delivery at the address provided in its last EDGAR filing with the Commission, in accordance with Commission Rule of Practice 141(a)(2)(ii). Granite Future's answer to the OIP was due by Monday, October 7, 2019. However, Granite Futures has neither filed an answer nor made any other response to the OIP in this proceeding.

The Respondents at issue are delinquent in their filings with the Commission and have been delinquent for over two years. In addition, the Respondents' failure to answer supports revocation of the registration of each class of the Respondents' securities. Accordingly, the Division moves for an order, pursuant to Rule 155(a)(2), finding these Respondents to be in default in this proceeding and ordering that the registration of each class of their securities registered pursuant to Exchange Act Section 12 be revoked.


**Conclusion**

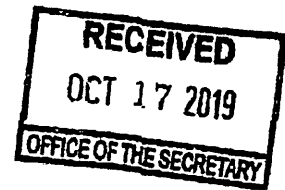

**DECLARATION OF GINA JOYCE  
TO ASSIST SECRETARY WITH RECORD OF SERVICE**

GINA JOYCE, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1746, declares:

1. I am a Senior Counsel with the Division of Enforcement (“Division”) of the Securities and Exchange Commission, and co-counsel for the Division in the captioned administrative proceeding. I am submitting this Declaration to assist the Secretary in maintaining a record of service on the respondents in the captioned proceedings pursuant to Rule 141(a)(3).

2. Among other means, Securities and Exchange Commission (“Commission”) Rule of Practice 141(a)(2)(ii) permits service on a corporation or entity by delivering a copy of an Order Instituting Administrative Proceedings (“OIP”) to an agent authorized by appointment or law to receive such service or, in the case of an issuer with a class of securities registered with the Commission, by sending the OIP via U.S. Postal Service certified, registered, or Express Mail and obtaining a confirmation of attempted delivery on the most recent address shown on the entity’s most recent filing with the Commission.

Further, the OIP in this matter authorizes service of the OIP “by any means permitted by the Commission’s Rules of Practice.” Therefore, the Division asked the Commission’s Secretary to first attempt service on the Respondents via U.S. Priority Mail Express.

3. The Office of the Secretary provided me with the U.S. Priority Mail Express tracking numbers and a Registered Mail tracking number for the copies of the Order Instituting Proceedings (“OIP”)<sup>1</sup> that were mailed by the Secretary to the respondents in these proceedings. I input each of the tracking numbers into the U.S. Postal Service’s (“USPS”) package tracking system on its Internet website located at [www.usps.com](http://www.usps.com), and printed out the tracking confirmations in order to obtain confirmation of the delivery or attempted delivery of the OIP on each respondent. A true copy of the tracking confirmations for all of the respondents for whom express mail service was attempted is attached as Exhibit 1, hereto.

4. The Secretary mailed the OIP to respondent EMTA Corp. a/k/a Wiltex A, CIK 1171878 (“EMTA/Wiltex”), via Priority Mail Express, Tracking No. ER 006877374 US, to the address shown on its most recent EDGAR filing at 1191 Woodstock, Suite #5, Estes Park, Colorado 80517. This address is taken from EMTA/Wiltex’s last filing with the Commission, which was a Form 10-QSB/A filed with the Commission on September 10, 2004. The USPS tracking system confirms that delivery was attempted on September 24, 2019. The package was refused. The package was returned to the SEC. *See* Exhibit 1 at pp. 1 - 3.

5. Fuzzy Logic Software Corp. a/k/a China Global Solar Corporation Limited, CIK 1098799 (“Fuzzy Logic”) is located in Canada. In order to determine if mail service is an

acceptable means of service in Canada, I determined that both Canada and the United States are signatories to the Hague Convention on the Service Abroad of Judicial and Extrajudicial Documents in Civil or Commercial Matters (“The Hague Convention”), 20 U.S.T. 361, T.I.A.S. 6638, 658 U.N.T.A. 163 (1964). Article 10(a) of the Hague Convention provides that, unless the country of destination objects, parties may send judicial documents directly to persons abroad through postal channels. Canada does not object to such service. *See Randolph v. Hendry*, 50 F. Supp.2d 572, 578 (S.D.W.Va. 1999).

6. The Secretary mailed the OIP to respondent Fuzzy Logic, via Registered Mail, Tracking No. RA 253388199 US, to the address shown on its most recent EDGAR filing at 505 Burrard Street, Suite 680, Vancouver, BC V7X 1M4, Canada. This address is taken from Fuzzy Logic’s last filing with the Commission, which was a Form 10-KSB filed with the Commission on November 12, 2002. The USPS tracking system confirms that delivery was attempted on October 9, 2019. The addressee could not be located. The package was returned. *See Exhibit 1 at pp. 4 - 7.*

7. The Secretary mailed the OIP to respondent Granite Futures Fund Limited Partnership, CIK 882257 (“Granite Futures”), via Priority Mail Express, Tracking No. ER 006877360 US, to the address shown on its most recent EDGAR filing at c/o McCormick Futures Management, Inc., 190 S. LaSalle Street, Suite 2830, Chicago, IL 60603. This address is taken from Granite Futures’s last filing with the Commission, which was a Form 10-Q filed with the Commission on August 8, 1994. The USPS tracking system confirms that delivery was attempted on September 24, 2019. It was




determined that there was no such [suite] number. The package was returned to the SEC.
