STATUS REPORT REGARDING SHOW CAUSE ORDER

The Division of Enforcement respectfully submits this Status Report in connection with the Commission's Show Cause Order.

1. On July 27, 2021, the Commission issued its show cause order requiring Respondent to show cause by August 10, 2021, why the registration of its securities should not be revoked by default due to its failure to file an answer and to otherwise defend this proceeding (the "Show Cause Order").

2. The Show Cause Order notified Respondent that if it failed to comply, the Respondent could be deemed in default, the proceeding could be determined against it, and the registration of its securities could be revoked.

3. As of August 24, 2022, Respondent has not served any response to the Show Cause Order upon the Division.
