DIVISION OF ENFORCEMENT'S MOTION TO DISMISS

Pursuant to Rule 154 of the Commission's Rules of Practice, the Division of Enforcement ("DOE") respectfully requests that the Securities and Exchange Commission ("Commission") dismiss these proceedings against Respondent Clifton Curtis Sneed, Jr. ("Respondent").

On October 15, 2021, the Commission instituted this proceeding by issuing an Order Instituting Administrative Proceedings Pursuant to Section 203(f) of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940 against Respondent ("OIP"). This is a follow-on proceeding to determine what, if any, remedial action is appropriate and in the public interest against Respondent following the entry of an injunction against him in the civil action entitled <u>Securities and Exchange Commission</u> v. Clifton Curtis Sneed, Jr., Civil Action No. 3:20-CV-2988 (N.D. Tex.).

On November 23, 2021, Respondent was served with the OIP. (Doc. 4) He did not answer and is in default.

On or about January 21, 2022, Respondent passed away. Because the Respondent is deceased, the relief requested in these proceedings cannot be implemented and there is no purpose or public benefit to continuing the proceedings.

For these reasons, the DOE respectfully requests that the Commission dismiss these proceedings.
