**DIVISION OF ENFORCEMENT'S MOTION FOR LEAVE
TO FILE A SCHEDULING MOTION**

This proceeding has been pending for more than three years and Respondent American CryptoFed DAO LLC's representatives have represented that they plan to seek relief in District Court to force the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission ("Commission") to take action on its pending motion to lift the stay on the effectiveness of its Form 10 (*See* May 12, 2025 letter to the Commission filed in this matter). The Division of Enforcement ("Division") remains ready to move this proceeding forward and requests permission to file a motion to set either a schedule for briefing Summary Disposition or a schedule for a full hearing on the merits. We recognize that the Commission has denied the Division's past requests to set a Summary Disposition briefing schedule, but due to the passage of time and the contents of the May 12, 2025 letter, the Division respectfully renews that request. In the alternative, the Division requests permission to file a motion seeking a hearing date on the merits of the allegations in the Order Instituting Proceedings in order to fully resolve this proceeding on the merits.

The Division met and conferred with the representatives from American CryptoFed on May 16, 2025 regarding these requests. They made clear that they opposed both of these requests

as well as any other effort to move these proceedings forward unless and until the Commission first ruled on their motion to lift the stay on the effectiveness of the Form 10.
