The Division of Enforcement of the Securities and Exchange Commission (the “Division”) respectfully submits this Status Report pursuant to the Commission’s September 1, 2023 Order Regarding Service of Amended Order Instituting Administrative Proceedings. *See Hughe Duwayne Graham*, Securities Exchange Act Rel. No. 98273 (September 1, 2023) (the “Order”). The Order directed the Division to file a status report concerning service of the amended order instituting administrative proceedings (“amended OIP”) in this matter, and every 28 days thereafter until service is accomplished.

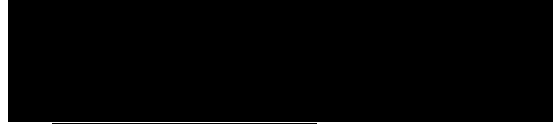
