RESPONDENT'S MOTION TO STAY DISCOVERY PENDING DECISION ON PETITION FOR INTERLOCUTORY REVIEW

Respondent hereby moves for a stay of discovery pending the Commission's decision on his Petition for Interlocutory Review, filed on February 26, 2025.

The Petition challenges, *inter alia*, the correctness of the Administrative Law Judge's January 30, 2025 Order on Subpoena Request, which requires Respondent to comply with a subpoena that he believes to be unlawful. The subpoena and the ALJ's subsequent order purport to require compliance by March 5, 2025. Without a stay of discovery, the compliance date might arrive before the Commission has ruled on the Petition for Interlocutory Review. Respondent respectfully suggests that this unfair result would be avoided by staying discovery until the Commission's decision.

For the foregoing reasons, discovery should be temporarily stayed.
