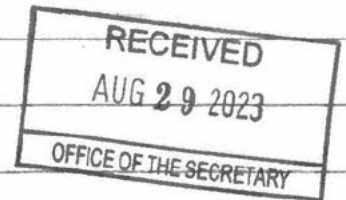

I respectfully ask the Court and the SEC
to put a stay on this matter.

I am currently serving a sentence in federal prison
for a single count of securities fraud.

My release date is currently June 2028.

I respectfully reserve my right to defend myself and my actions which have been misrepresented.

If I was served by the SEC in this matter in September 2022 as alleged, I was incapable financially, mentally, and emotionally to understand and address this matter at that time as I was preparing to fight for my life, reputation and freedom in criminal court.

This matter has only now been brought to my attention.

I believe allegations currently and previously made by the SEC are egregious and stem from a personal matter by Lynn Dear.

For example: Dear is alleging a "ponzi-scheme" when the U.S. Attorney stated in Federal Court that there was "No evidence of a Ponzi-scheme" as the FBI investigation relates to the matter of Longvue, Bayside, Freedom Fund, or Simple Growth.

I believe with proper council and preparation I can prove there are other misstatements of fact made by Dear in this matter.
