DIVISION OF ENFORCEMENT'S STATUS REPORT REGARDING SERVICE

Pursuant to the February 23, 2023 Order in this matter, the Division of Enforcement of the Securities and Exchange Commission ("Division") submits this status report regarding service on Ron K. Harrison ("Respondent" or "Harrison").

This administrative action against Harrison pursuant to Section 203(f) of Investment

Advisers Act of 1940 was instituted on September 21, 2022. The Secretary's Office served the

on September 21, 2022.

The Secretary's Office did not provide us with a copy of the Certified Mail receipt for the

mailing to Harrison. See Declaration of Kathryn C. Wanner ("Wanner Decl."), ¶2. On March 6,

2023, we reached out to the Secretary's Office, which confirmed they had mailed the OIP on

September 21, 2022, and that they had not received a return receipt for the mailing, but would

"look through our returned mail." See Wanner Decl. ¶3, Ex. A.

On November 8, 2022, in an abundance of caution, we also had Harrison personally

served at his last known address at

Harrison has also been sued by the Securities and Exchange Commission in the Central

District of California in an action titled SEC v. Ron K. Harrison, et al., Case No. 8:21-cv-01610-

JVS-DFM. Harrison is proceeding pro se in that matter. See Wanner Decl. ¶5, Ex. C. Harrison

has provided a declaration in that matter listing his address as the Mercantile Way address. *Id.*

According to Central District of California Local Rule 41-6, a pro se party is obligated to keep

the Court and all other parties informed of the party's current address as well as any telephone

number and email address. See Wanner Decl. ¶6, Ex. D. Harrison's address according to his

filings with the Central District remains the Mercantile Way address. *Id.* Moreover, during the

course of the District Court litigation, the Division has served Harrison via U.S. Mail at the

Mercantile Way address numerous times and these mailings have not been returned. See Wanner

Decl. ¶7.

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
