FINRA'S MOTION TO DISMISS THE APPEAL AS ABANDONED AND STAY THE BRIEFING SCHEDULE

Pursuant to Commission Rules of Practice 154 and 180(c), FINRA moves to dismiss the application for review filed by Wilfredo Felix as abandoned. Felix has not filed a brief in support of his application for review by the January 18, 2023 deadline established by the Commission in this proceeding, nor has he requested an extension of time to file the brief. In support of its motion, FINRA states:

- 1. On October 13, 2022, FINRA's National Adjudicatory Council ("NAC") issued a disciplinary decision finding that Felix violated FINRA Rule 8210 and barring him for this misconduct. (RP¹ 569-85). Felix, proceeding pro se, served FINRA with an application for review of the NAC's decision on November 15, 2022. (RP 615-20).
- 2. On December 19, 2022, the Commission issued an Order Scheduling Briefs (the "Order"). The Order required Felix to file a brief in support of his application for review by

January 18, 2023 and warned that his failure to do so "may result in dismissal of this review

proceeding."

3. Upon information and belief, Felix did not file a brief with the Commission by the

January 18, 2023 deadline established by the Order and, to date, he has not filed a brief or sought

an extension of time to do so. On January 19 and 23, 2023, undersigned counsel sent emails to

Felix requesting that he provide FINRA with any brief he filed pursuant to the Order. Counsel

sent the emails, which attached the Order, to the same email address Felix used to serve FINRA

with his application for review. Felix has not responded to the emails, nor has he served FINRA

with any document he may have filed pursuant to the Order.

4. Commission Rule of Practice 180(c) provides that the Commission may dismiss a

case if a party fails to make a filing required under the Rules of Practice. Under the

circumstances, the Commission should treat Felix's appeal as abandoned because he has failed to

file a brief pursuant to the Order.

5. Finally, FINRA's brief in opposition is due on February 17, 2023. FINRA

requests that the Commission stay the briefing schedule while this motion remains pending.
