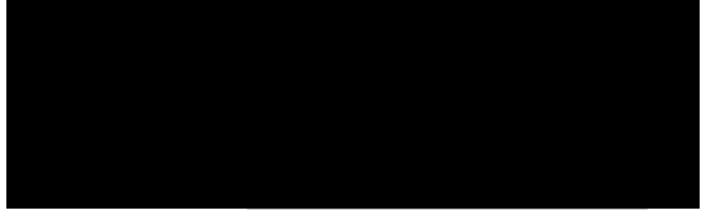
DIVISION OF ENFORCEMENT'S STATUS REPORT

The Division of Enforcement (“the Division”) is writing this status report to update the Commission on its efforts to serve 3D PIONEER SYSTEMS, INC. (“Respondent”) in accordance with the Commission’s August 14, 2023 Order Regarding Service. The Division is in the process of preparing the necessary documents to serve the Nevada Secretary of State. As part of that effort, the Division is also attempting to serve the company directly at its Australia address via USPS Registered Mail.¹

¹ Australia does not object to service by postal channels, where it is permitted in the jurisdiction in which the process is to be served. Documents forwarded via postal channels must be sent via registered mail to enable acknowledgement of receipt. See <https://www.hcch.net/en/instruments/conventions/status-table/notifications/?csid=1062&disp=resdn>. Queensland Civil and Administrative Tribunal Rules 2009-Reg 39(1)(b) allows documents to be given to an entity in a proceeding by sending by post to the entity’s usual or last known residential or business address. See Also *Waraich v. Nat’l Australia Bank Ltd.*, No. H-18-4069, 2019 WL 1003625, at *3 (S.D. Tex. Feb. 28, 2019) (“Australia ‘does not object to service by postal channels, where it is permitted in the jurisdiction in which the process is to be served.’”) (quoting webpage of the Hague Conference on Private International Law website, <https://www.hcch.net/en/states/authorities/details3/?aid=878> (last visited Jan. 29, 2021); *Stafford v.
