DIVISION OF ENFORCEMENT'S
MOTION TO DISMISS

Pursuant to Rule 154 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and 17 C.F.R. § 200.30- 10(a)(8), the Division of Enforcement ("Division") respectfully requests that the Securities and Exchange Commission ("Commission") dismiss these proceedings against Respondent Ronald Shane Flynn ("Respondent") because he is deceased.

On July 14, 2023, the Commission instituted this proceeding by issuing an Order Instituting Administrative Proceedings Pursuant to Section 15(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against Respondent ("OIP"). This is a follow-on proceeding to determine what, if any remedial action is appropriate and in the public interest against Respondent following the entry of an injunction against him in the civil action titled *Securities and Exchange Commission v. Vuuzle Media Corp., et al.*, Civil Action No. 2:21-cv-1226 (D.N.J.).

On or about July 18, 2023, the Office of the Secretary sent Respondent the OIP by email and USPS mailing to a Dubai, UAE address that Commission records indicated was, at one time, Respondent's home address. The mailing was eventually returned to the Commission as undeliverable, but the email was not. On October 26, 2023, the Commission issued an Amended Order Instituting Administrative Proceedings Pursuant to Section 15(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 ("Amended OIP"). On or about October 26, 2023,

the Division sent Respondent the Amended OIP and other papers by email and USPS mailing Respondent's Dubai, UAE address. The mailing was eventually returned to the Division as undeliverable, but the email was not. On February 22, 2024, the Commission granted the Division's motion for alternative means of service, and, on February 22, 2024, the Division served a copy of the order granting the Division's motion and the Amended OIP on Respondent by email. Respondent has not answered or otherwise responded to the Amended OIP.

Respondent died on or about May 14, 2024. His death record is submitted herewith. Because the Respondent is deceased, the relief requested in these proceedings cannot be implemented, and there is no purpose or public benefit to continuing the proceedings. For these reasons, the Division respectfully requests that the Commission dismiss these proceedings.
